The project consists of the partial reconfiguration and renovation of the second, third, and fourth floors of the College of Medicine West Tower Building to create a state of the art, high tech educational space. The project created several classrooms, seminar spaces, independent and group learning spaces, a lounge space, administration headquarters for the student service units, expansion of existing toilet facilities, new finishes, furniture and AV-equipment, distance learning, audience response and wireless access, new programmable lighting, mechanical, electrical, fire protection and security systems.
