Nationwide Children's Hospital has erected a 40,000 sq foot building to accommodate a 20,000 sq ft Ambulatory Surgery Center on the first floor and miscellaneous services on the second floor. This Greenfield project was built near NCH Close to Home facility, providing emergency and now surgical care to local residents. The project included 4 operating rooms with all medical gases, equipment booms and pre-post op swing spaces. Special care was taken to develop each program area with the users, facilities and Design and Construction to develop this first off campus Center where services will not be just a block away at the Main Hospital.

**Vision:**

- All infrastructure was designed with I-2 scenarios maintained in an ambulatory budget.
- Flexible spaces for Pre-Post Op keeping patient flow and parent convenience in mind.

- Mechanical Spaces on second floor to maximize first floor clinical spaces
- MOB on second floor to economize HVAC system strategy to maximize total construction budget
